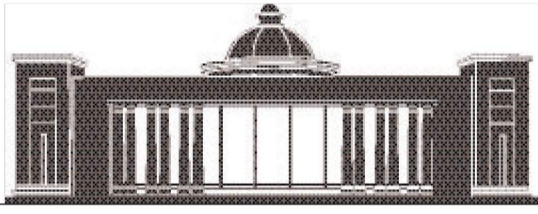

ON FEBRUARY 10, the Gujarat BJP will organise a programme wherein Prime Minister Narendra Modi is scheduled to virtually address around 10 lakh party workers in all the 182 Assembly constituencies of Gujarat, state party chief CR Paatil announced in Khambhat Sunday. "It will be a world record where PM Modi will address 10 lakh people in Gujarat virtually," Paatil said. According to Paatil, Gujarat party MLAs, MPs and organisation will assemble more than 5,000 workers and beneficiaries of various government schemes in each constituency and Modi will virtually address them from Delhi.

PM lays emphasis on Hindu religious sites' development

Talks of peace initiatives taken by BJP governments in Northeast

PRIME MINISTER Narendra Modi during his visit to Guwahati on Sunday emphasised on the BJP's focus on developing Hindu religious sites.

Modi arrived in Assam on Saturday evening, his first visit to the Northeast since the ethnic violence broke out in Manipur last May. Though he was supposed to address a political rally in Mizoram on October 30, 2023, in the run-up to the Assembly elections there, the visit was cancelled a few days before it was scheduled. The Congress had alleged that the visit was called off because Modi had not visited Manipur even once since the violence broke out.

During an event in Guwahati on Sunday afternoon, Modi inaugurated multiple infrastructure projects in the state, estimated to cost over Rs 11,000 crore. These included the Kamakhya temple corridor, which is supposed to be on the lines of the Kashi Vishwanath temple corridor in Varanasi.

At the event Modi said, "After the Kashi corridor was made, a record number of devotees reached there. (A total of) 8.5 crore people went to Kashi last year... More than 19 lakh people went on pilgrimage to Kedarnath. In Ayodhya, the Pran Pratishtha (of Ram Lalla) was done just a few days ago. In 12 days, more than 24 lakh people have had a darshan. After the Maa Kamakhya Divyalok Pariyojana is made, we will see a similar sight here."

"When pilgrims and devotees come, even the poorest earn, be it rickshaw wallas, taxi drivers, hotel operators, vendors... That's why in this year's (Interim) Budget we have given a lot of weightage to tourism... In Assam and NE, there is a lot of potential for this. That is why the BJP government is giving a lot of emphasis to development here," he said.

"Our pilgrimage sites, our temples, our religious places are not just sites for darshan. They are symbols of our thousands of years of civilization. Bharat has remained strong even after facing every difficulty... After Independence, those who ran

governments in this country for long, even they did not realise the importance of the sacred places of worship. For their political benefit, they had started a trend of being ashamed of their own culture," he said.

In his address, he claimed that the BJP governments have made strides in bringing peace in the Northeast, but he abstained from mentioning Manipur in his speech. "Today, the Northeast believes in Modi Ki Guarantee. If you see Assam, areas which were strife-torn are now witnessing peace. Border disputes between states are being resolved. After the formation

of the BJP government, more than 10 big peace settlements have been arrived at. In the past few years, thousands of youths have chosen the path of development over that of violence... More than 7,000 youths of Assam have put down arms... AFSPA has been removed from many districts," he said.

The other projects inaugurated include upgrade of Guwahati's Nehru Stadium, various road projects, foundation stone laying for upgrading facilities at Guwahati Medical College and Hospital and of Karimganj Medical College and Hospital.

Gujarat police detain Islamic preacher from Mumbai for hate speech

A TEAM from the Gujarat police reached Mumbai and detained Islamic preacher Mufti Salman Azhari in connection with a case of hate speech it is probing.

After Azhari was brought to the Ghatkopar police station, his supporters gathered outside the police station demanding his immediate release. The crowd also impacted traffic in the area.

Junagadh police arrested two persons Saturday after a video of an inflammatory speech allegedly delivered by the preacher went viral on social media. The speech was delivered at an event held on an open ground near the 'B' division police station in Junagadh on the night of January 31, he said.

After the video went viral, an

FIR was registered against Azhari and local organisers — Mohammad Yousuf Malek and Azim Habib Odedara — under IPC sections 153B (promoting enmity between different religious groups) and 505 (2) (making statements conducive to public mischief). While two persons were arrested in the case, the Gujarat police was looking for Azhari who was detained from Ghatkopar. The police is likely to take his transit remand from a Mumbai court and take him to Gujarat for further probe.

'Emotional' Chirag Patel joins BJP; likely to get bypoll ticket, hints Paatil

CHIRAG PATEL, who resigned as the Congress MLA from Khambhat constituency in December, has become the latest to jump ship to the BJP in Gujarat ahead of the general elections. On Sunday, Patel joined the saffron party along with his supporters in the presence of state party president CR Paatil.

Welcoming Patel into the party, Paatil indicated that Patel would be BJP's candidate in the Khambhat bypoll. "I will come again (to Khambhat) for the victory procession," Paatil said.

Ahead of joining the party, an emotional Patel said the BJP was his gotra and said he had decided to join the party unconditionally only for the welfare of his constituency. Addressing Paatil, Patel said, "Sir, take special care of my Khambhat. When I had come seeking your blessings, I had said that, 'I do not want anything. But think about my Khambhat'."

Paatil promised him to resolve Khambhat's water problem, he added.

Praising Prime Minister Narendra Modi's leadership,

Paatil said he has linked the entire country through the thread of Ram Mandir. He said that under such leadership and with the strength of the party workers, it is always possible to win all 182 seats of the Gujarat Assembly.

The BJP state chief added that his pledge to win all 182 seats could not be fulfilled in the assembly elections of 2022 as some seats were lost with small margins. He also called upon the workers to do the same in the next assembly elections.

"I had taken a pledge (in the 2022 assembly polls) to win all 182 seats in the state. When we will have the next assembly election, I may not be around as the party president, but you (party workers) should win all 182 seats," Paatil said.

Patel is among the four MLAs who recently resigned from the Gujarat Assembly. He resigned in December. In the 2022 Assembly elections, Patel had defeated BJP's Mayur Raval by 3711 votes.

The other three MLAs who resigned include Aam Aadmi Party's (AAP's) Bhubendra Bhayani, Congress's C J Chavda and independent Dharmendrasinh Vaghela. Bhayani joined the BJP Saturday in Bhesan of Junagadh in the presence of Paatil.

23% manpower shortage in CBI: DoPT annual report

New Delhi: The CBI is facing a shortage of 23% manpower, including in the posts of Special Director, Joint Directors and DIGs, said the Department of Personnel and Training in their 2022-23 annual report as 1,025 cases - 943 registered cases and 82 preliminary enquiries - were pending.

"Till December 31, 2022, the total sanctioned strength of CBI was 7,295 against which 5,600 officers were in position and 1,695 posts were vacant," the report

said. Till December 31, 2020, CBI's total sanctioned strength was 7,273 and of them, 1,374 posts were vacant, the report said, adding that in 2021, 1,533 posts were vacant. As per the report, the vacancies are in the rank of one Special/Additional Director, two Joint Directors, 11 DIGs, 9 SSPs, one Additional SP, 65 Deputy SPs, 360 inspectors, 204 sub-inspectors, 51 assistant sub-inspectors, 123 head constables, 281 constables, and 367 technical officers.
